Mortality projections


- Projecting mortality is not just a statistical exercise

- The development of life expectancy depends on:
 - Medical development
 - And is it available?
 - Behaviour
 - Environment
 - (drinking water, one of the most important drivers)
 - Pollution
 - Water, air
 - Climate

Mortality projections Issues

- For developed countries: how long does the "Vaupel line" continues?
- Less developed countries: converting to other countries in same region?
- Lower developed countries: development life expectancy mainly depends on and not on their own history:
 - Availability of medicines
 - Availability clean drinking water
